

Construction Activity during February consisted of the following:

- No work done on project during the month of February due to rain and wet soil conditions. No work is possible due to saturated soil conditions along the roadway embankments and access road locations.
- Work has continued with the development of a contract change order for Pavex to provide a full roadway asphalt overlay. It is anticipated that this work may be able to be done in April (night time temperatures permitting)
- Redesign work and a subsequent change order were completed to allow for a break in the median barrier at Grant Line Rd. This work will be carried out in the spring, after the AC overlay has been completed.

Due to the extreme wet weather on the job the contractor has not been able to proceed with contract work on the site other than making sure all SWPPP and Site Safety requirements are kept up and in place. Contractor hopes for March to be a productive month for the project (weather permitting).
